- 4. Local and county SARB coordination.
- 5. Process and respond to Requests for Investigation and SARB Referrals.
- 6. SARB Contract/Agreement monitoring and follow-up conferences and visits.
- 7. Coordinates filing of charges against parents for SARB violations with the District Attorney's Office.
- 8. Support for school administrators and nursing personnel with potentially dangerous home visits and conferences.
- 9. Providing consultation and liaison to law enforcement on school safety, security, and crisis response planning.

Contract amounts are calculated on October 2018 CBEDS enrollment.

The annual contract amount of \$100 includes cost for services provided by the DEPARTMENT to the DISTRICT for the 2019-2020 school year. Services will include but not be limited to coordination, technical assistance, preparation, distribution, management, and monitoring for the following:

- 1. Complete and electronically submit Part I (Spring, June), and Part II (Winter, February) of the Consolidated Application (CARS).
- 2. Assist, review and monitor the LCAP ESSA Federal Addendum and LCAP.
- 3. Assist Districts in the transition to the Federal, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).
- 4. Provide School Site Council (SSC) training.
- 5. Provide Federal Program Monitoring (FPM) assistance.
- 6. Provide training on the California Monitoring Tool (CMT). In addition, to assist with CMT submissions for those districts selected.
- 7. Maintain contact with the California Department of Education to keep schools updated on changes with categorical funding.
- 8. Serve as the Lead Agency for the Title III LEP Consortium, holding meetings during the year. (September, January, March and May).
- 9. Hold Luncheon Meetings (October, January, and May) to review ESSA changes.
- 10. School Plan assistance, writing, monitoring, and reviewing for compliance.
- 11. Lead Agency for Administrative Services with Document Tracking System (DTS).

WHEREAS, the Flournoy Elementary School District and the Elkins Elementary School District are both small rural districts approximately six miles apart that both lost their necessary small school funding as a result of the implementation of the Local Control Funding Formula.

WHEREAS, the Flournoy Elementary School District shares a territory boundary with Elkins Elementary School District; and

WHEREAS, the Flournoy Elementary School District and the Elkins Elementary School District held a joint board meeting on March 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Flournoy Elementary School District Board publicly stated their desire to become the partner in the Elkins Elementary School District's lapsation; and

WHEREAS, the Flournoy Elementary School District is suffering from the same financial pressures of meeting the requirements for necessary small school funding that underlies the Elkins Elementary School District's pending lapse; and

WHEREAS, a reorganization of Flournoy Elementary School District with the Elkins Elementary School District would allow the two districts to pool resources and preserve the historic local option of a small school; and

WHEREAS, the Elkins School District Board took action to select the Flournoy Elementary School District as the receiving district in the pending Japsation at their May 14, 2019 meeting:

THEREFORE, be it resolved the Flournoy Elementary School District does hereby affirm their desire and commitment to partnering with the Elkins Elementary School District with the reorganization to take effect on July 1, 2020 pending confirmation by the State Board of Education and the Tehama County Committee on School District Organization.

WHEREAS, the Elkins Elementary School District is a component district of the Corning Union High School District.

WHEREAS, upon lapsation the Elkins Elementary School District will be annexed into the Flournoy Elementary School District which is a component district of the Corning Union High School District.

WHEREAS, The Elkins Elementary School District noticed the community and parents to solicit input on the issue of lapsation in which no objections were raised.

WHEREAS, The Elkins Elementary School District is requesting that the California State Board of Education waive a portion of the California Education Code sections 35780, 35782, and 35783 (see attached) to allow lapsation of the District and annexation of its territory into the Flournoy Elementary School District pursuant to Education Code sections 35780 through 35783.

WHEREAS, the Elkins Elementary School District is requesting that the California State Board of Education waive a portion of the California Education Code sections 35780, 35782, and 35783 to allow the Tehama County Committee on School District Organization to lapse the Elkins Elementary School District and to hold a public hearing before June 30, 2020, and make the lapsation effective July 1, 2020.

35780. (a) A school district that has been organized for more than three years shall be lapsed as provided in this article if the number of registered electors in the school district is less than six or if the average daily attendance of pupils in the school or schools maintained by the school district is less than six in grades 1 through 8 or is less than 11 in grades 9 through 12, except that for any unified district that has established and continues to operate at least one senior high school, the board of supervisors shall defer the lapsation of the school district one year upon a written request of the governing board of the school district and written concurrence of the county committee. The board of supervisors shall make no more than three such deferments.

35782. Within 45 days before the close of each school year, the county committee shall conduct a public hearing on the issues specified in Section 35780. Notice of the public hearing shall be given at least 10 days in advance of the hearing to each member of the governing board of the lapsed district immediately before its lapsation, to each of the governing boards that adjoin the lapsed district, and to the high school district of which the lapsed elementary district is a component.

35783 After the hearing, and at least 30 days before the end of the school year, the county committee shall order the territory annexed to one or more adjoining districts as seems to the county committee to be in the best interest of the adjoining districts and the residents of the lapsed district.
